SUMMERTIME AND HOLIDAYS

For travel to Europe make sure you have the EHIC medical card. If you can access the surgery website the Travel Advice section is worth reading.



LOOKING AHEAD

The surgery will be holding **flu vaccination** days in late September and



October. Eligible patients will be notified. It would be a huge help to the surgery if patients could attend the surgery for their flu vaccinations as the correct patient number of vaccines have to be ordered and paid for well in advance and only 10% of any un-used

vaccines are refundable. Patients are often offered the vaccines from other sources and if accepted results in a significant financial loss to the surgery. Thank you for your help with this.

Covid vaccination days will be in October.

Eligible patients will be notified about appointments nearer the time.

The surgery PPG will again be helping with duties in the car park on vaccination days. If any patients are able to help and would like to volunteer, please write your name, contact phone, and email if available, and heading 'Vaccination Day Help Interest' on a card and put it into the wooden PPG box at reception. You will be contacted about the help needed. Thank you.
